Our Recycling Guidelines

To help our customers identify and recycle materials correctly, we have developed these **Material Recycling Guidelines**.

This guide provides information on the recyclability of both our products and the packaging materials used to transport them. The sections below outline the various product and packaging types and provide guidance on their appropriate recycling and disposal routes.

Partnered Recycling Schemes

Correx

1. Order your Correx collection bag
2. Consolidate all Correx waste onto a pallet within the collection bag
3. When bag is full, use the straps to secure the Correx
4. Call Beck UK to arrange collection – 01432 263598



Timber

1. Call 0800 282488 or Email collection@scott-pallets.com to register the site.
2. A minimum quantity of 50 pallets applies per collection, where fewer than 50 pallets a £100 transport charge will apply.
3. To arrange a collection Email collection@scott-pallets.com with a covering purchase order of £3.50 per pallet to cover any pallets deemed non-reusable as per the attached. Reusable pallets will be collected Free of charge, and the covering purchase order will not be processed.
4. Stack pallets safely ready for collection. The collection will be completed within 10 working days of receiving the call-off.
5. Load the vehicle that comes to collect within 1 hour of the vehicle arriving to avoid any demurrage charges.

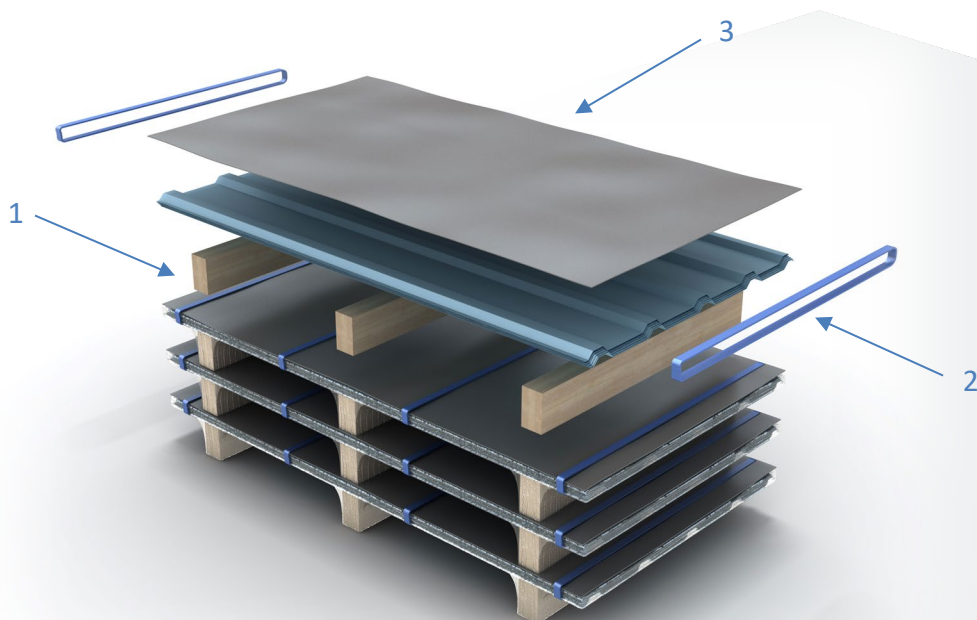

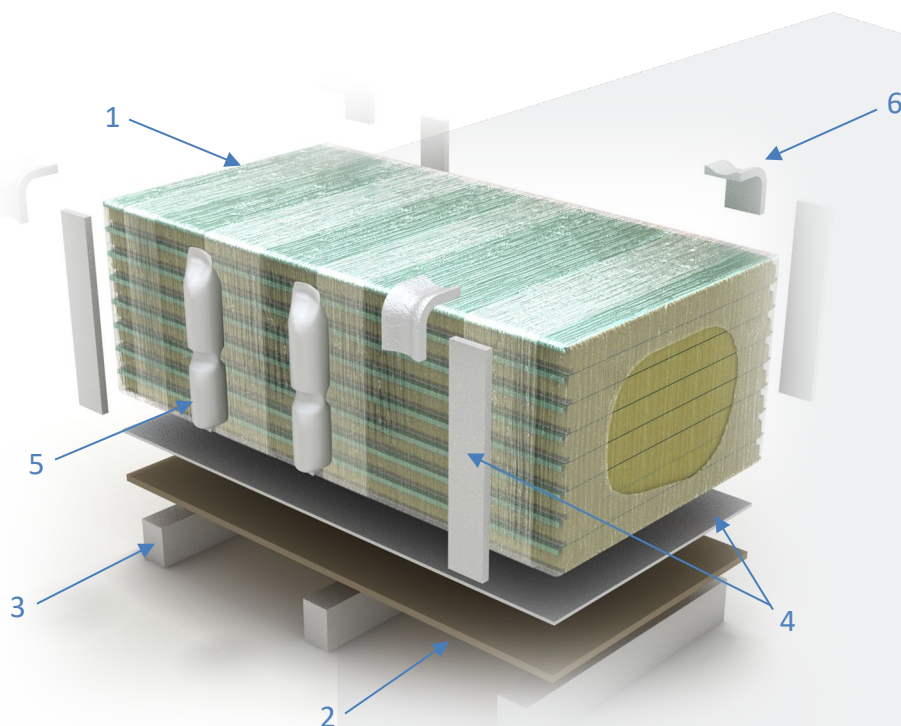

Panel Product

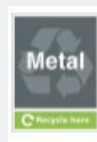
Our panel products can be recycled through standard waste and recycling streams when separated into their individual component materials. Where offcuts or damaged panels are generated on site, remove the outer steel facings from the stone wool core to allow each material to be recycled separately. Once separated, both the **steel** and **stone wool** components can be taken to local recycling facilities and processed under the recycling codes shown below.
